

April 12, 2011

The April 12, 2011 meeting of the Friends of the O'Fallon Library (FOTOL) was called to order at 5:00pm by president Ann Sullivan. Seven members were present. Minutes of the January 11, 2011 meeting were posted on the O'Fallon Library web site and were available at the meeting. They were approved as written.

The treasurer's report was presented by Harriet Baker. The current balance is \$671.05. The income from the various mini book sales averaged at \$300 each week starting in January.

Library director Molly Scanlan thanked the group for its recent donation of \$500. Also, \$5000 from the friends of the library has been given to cover the costs of a new copier and the Summer Reading Program. Molly said the large conference room is reserved for the Friends until 5:00pm on the Monday's following the mini-book sales so there will be time available for tear down.

Donations have started to pick up again and sorting is being streamlined by limiting to Fiction and Nonfiction, hardback and softcover. The next mini-book sale will be held on May 21st and 22nd with set-up starting at 1:00pm on Friday, the 20th. As always volunteers are needed to help with all aspects of the sale. The room will also be available 9-5 Monday, May 23rd for clean up.

It was decided that the book sales hours be extended to 3:00pm on Saturday, especially for the May sale. Sales from 1pm to 3pm will be covered by the Circulation staff.

The registration forms will be sent to volunteers and new board members for the 2011-12 year.

Meeting was adjourned at 5:30pm. The next meeting will be held August 9, 2011.
